

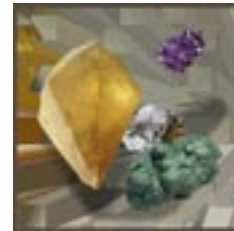
Corporate Identity Mural

Bonny Lhotka was commissioned to create a corporate history mural for the offices of Resource Capital Funds, Denver, Colorado. The company provided over 100 source images for use in the mural. Many of the images were 35-mm slides of mining sites from around the world. Lhotka selected the Microtek ArtixScanner 4000t to capture the high-resolution images she needed for the work. Magazines, maps and old stock certificates were scanned on the Microtek ScanMaker 5.



Kodak gloss artist canvas was used for printing the 44" x 96" image on the Mutoh Falcon with pigment inks. An over coat of varnish was applied to the print for protection. After mounting the canvas to International Paper's GatorFoam it was installed in the corporate conference room.



Lhotka created two 36"x36" 3D animated lenticular images for the reception area using the company's collection of minerals which she photographed with the Olympus E20 digital camera. The files were interlaced with 3D Genius. They were printed on Roland's HighGloss PETG film on the Mutoh Falcon using the PhotoScript Rip with pigment ink. It was laminated to Microlens 20lpi 3D lens.
